## Youth Sailing Program

### ***Waiver of liability / Covid -19 Affirmations / Authorization***

The Harbour Sailing Club, Inc.(HSC) aka Sail Queen's Harbour, is organized as a not for profit 501c3 Charitable Foundation for the purpose of introducing , training and promoting youth sailing and related boating activities by sponsoring membership programs and activities for youth of Queen's Harbour , their families and community.

I understand the activities and risks involved in youth sailing programs and activities and enroll my child, a minor, as an HSC junior sailing member in accordance with the applicable sailing membership program's terms and fees.

I authorize HSC officers and agents/ staff instructors to arrange for medical treatment and / or transportation of my child in case of accident or illness. I understand that I shall be responsible for the costs of such treatment and transportation.

**My child has not shown any signs of Covid-19 infection or been in a household / in contact with anyone where anyone has tested positive 14 days prior to start of program. I understand the risks involved with COVID -19. I will not allow child to attend program on a sailing day when child has a fever or is otherwise unwell. I will comply with all protocols established by the Club (Attached) for the safety and health of youth/ instructors. It is understood HSC cannot guarantee no risk.**

I agree that my child shall be required to wear a USCG approved Life Jacket at all times when in and around docks and when sailing.

**To the extent allowed by Florida General Laws, I waive any liabilities that the Harbor Sailing Club, Inc., Queen's Harbour Yacht Club, Inc., the Queen's Harbour Property Owners' Association, Inc. or Club Corp of America, Inc. its officers, directors, agents or employees might have for any accident or illness to me or my child arising directly or indirectly out of any HSC program.**

A waiver must be completed identifying each youth participating in an HSC program. .

## *Junior Sailing Membership Agreement*

Harbour Sailing Club, Inc. (HSC).aka 'Sail Queen's Harbour' (SQH),sponsors *Membership sailing programs* for youth, ages 6-15, wishing to learn to sail and participate in SQH sailing activities and events run by the Club's Sailing Committee, as Junior HSC Members.

HSC youth sailing programs are available to (1) youth of HSC, QHYC and QHYCC members (2) youth of Queen's Harbour residents and extended families; and, (3) youth of local families who do not reside in the Queen's Harbour community.

There will be a separate youth Membership Fee for each sailing program or activity. e.g., Summer Camps, Fall Sailing, and the like. Membership fees help pay/defray the cost of instruction, maintaining Club sailboats / assets, marina fees and insurance.

The term of a Junior Sailing membership is only for the Membership sailing program/ activity subscribed to by the youth's family. Adult memberships are offered for full or partial calendar year, with membership renewals commencing next following January 1.
